He earned his Ph.D. at the University of Montana and conducted his post-doctoral training at The Roche Institute of Molecular Biology and the Rocky Mountain Laboratories (NIAID, NIH). Dr. Marconi has ~25 years of experience in the study of pathogenic spirochetes. His current research interests are diverse and include the study of molecular mechanisms of pathogenesis of Lyme disease, tick borne relapsing fever and periodontal disease. Dr. Marconi is well recognized for his vaccine related research and has lectured worldwide. He has published over 85 papers, reviews and book chapters.
