## **Zoonoses in Companion Animal Practice- Are We Doing Enough?**

Dr. Jim Kazmierczak is the State Public Health Veterinarian with the Wisconsin Division of Public Health. He has been working there as a communicable disease epidemiologist since 1988. His job primarily involves the control and epidemiology of zoonotic diseases. Dr. Kazmierczak received a DVM degree from the University of Illinois and after seven years of clinical practice, returned to school to get his MS from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. He is currently an adjunct associate professor in the Department of Population Health Sciences within the UW's School of Medicine and Public Health, as well as in the Department of Pathobiological Sciences at the UW School of Veterinary Medicine.

**Discussion:** Prior to the lecture, there will be a discussion to follow up on the email survey that was distributed in July regarding communicating zoonotic disease risks with clients. **The discussion is limited to 20 people, so RSVP early if you would like to attend.** You do not need to have completed the survey to participate.
