Dr. Snyder is a graduate of Tufts University Cummings School of Veterinary Medicine. She completed a small animal medicine and surgery internship at Virginia-Maryland Regional College of Veterinary Medicine, and practiced small animal medicine in a private practice in Massachusetts prior to completing her residency in clinical pathology at North Carolina State University College of Veterinary Medicine. During her residency, she was an instructor in clinical pathology at North Carolina State University. Formerly, Dr. Snyder was assistant clinical professor of clinical pathology at University of Minnesota College of Veterinary Medicine and was assistant laboratory director of the clinical pathology laboratory at the University of Minnesota Veterinary Medical Center. Dr. Snyder was also staff pathologist at Antech Diagnostics in Minneapolis, MN.

After a brief review of urine formation, we will discuss all aspects of in-house urinalysis including quality control and stained sediment smear evaluation. Ancillary testing, including urine culture, crystal identification, biochemical tests on urine and protein measurement will also be covered in detail.
