She is a past president of the Specialty of Cardiology in the American College of Veterinary Medicine, and currently serves as staff cardiologist and Chief of Small Animal Services at UW Veterinary Care in Madison, WI. Dr. Stepien's research interests include myxomatous valve disease in whippets, systemic hypertension and therapy of congestive heart failure.
